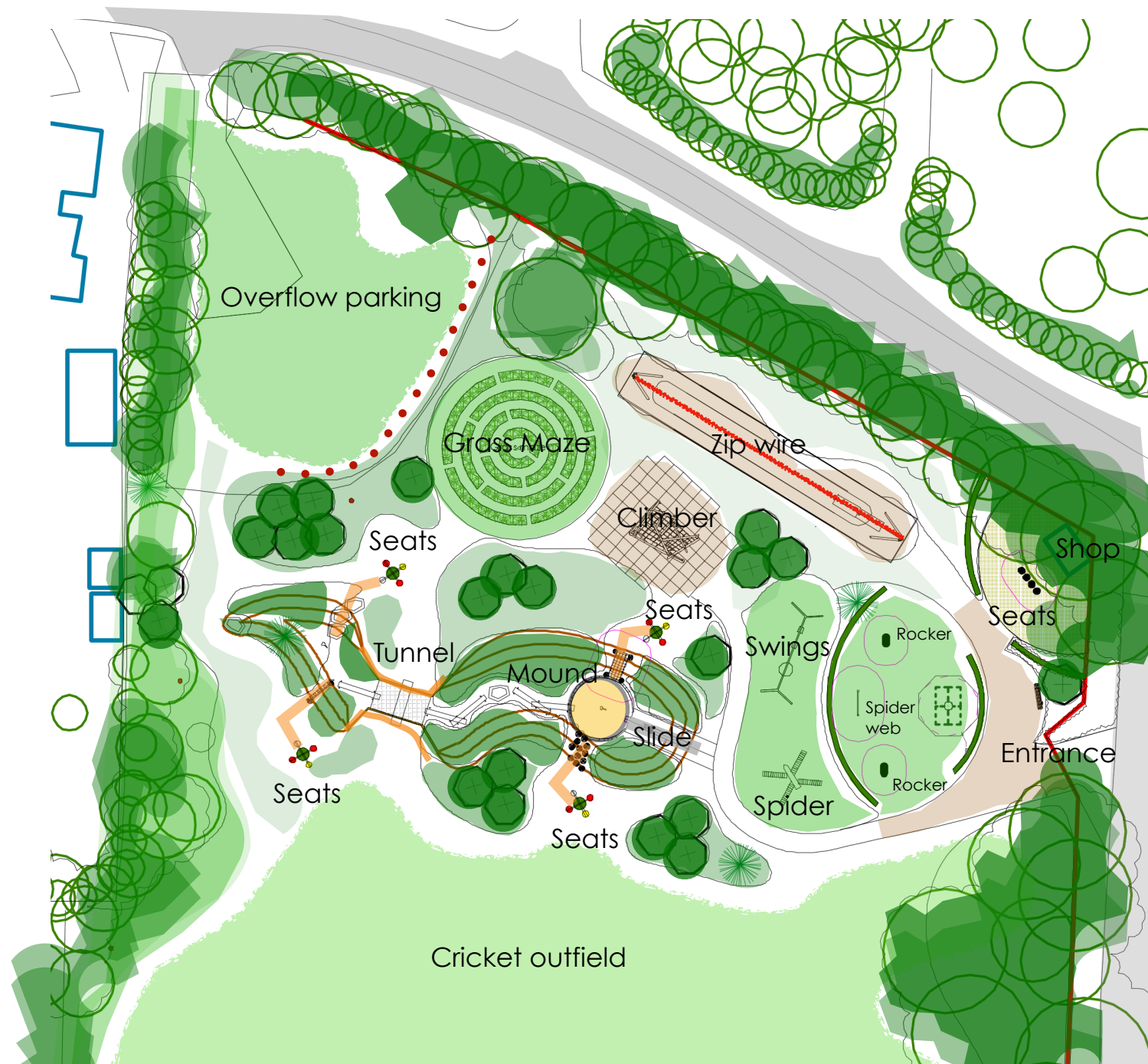




new play area masterplan - february 2020

This scheme has been funded from money given to the Parish Council as a result of other local building projects.

The design has evolved through work with a local landscape architect (Charles Potterton) and will be built by a local landscape contractor (HFN).

The original swings, 'burundi' climbing frame and our beloved red spider will remain. The building will be re-purposed as a shop. Other old and broken pieces will be removed.

The overall scheme is based on 'natural play' where children are encouraged to use their imagination. There are some new pieces of equipment, including a zip-wire, but these are laid out in a less formal way.

The central feature is a mound in the shape of a 'gecko' who is about to have the spider for his lunch...

Work will start in Spring 2020 and should take around 8 weeks to complete. It will take some time for all the grass to fully establish so we may not be able to open it all in one go. We expect it to be fully open with a launch celebration at the end of June.
